

DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

Continental Automotive GmbH processes your data in the course of using the WorkshopReport in accordance with applicable statutory regulations.

Continental hereby undertakes to only save personal data on Continental Automotive GmbH systems of customers who have consented to have their data collected and saved.

1. General

Any personal information you enter will be collected, processed and used by Continental Automotive GmbH for the purpose of using the reporting function (preparing a test report as part of tachograph calibration) with the WorkshopReport. Insofar as is required for processing the contract, the data may be transferred to companies associated with Continental Automotive GmbH within the meaning of Sections 15 et seq. of the German Stock Corporation Act in accordance with Continental's Binding Corporate Rules.

If permitted or required by law, the data may be analyzed for reporting purposes (e.g. statistics). Your data will be collected, processed and used based solely on the applicable data protection regulations (e.g. with your consent).

To ensure the availability of the memory services, we transfer data to our service provider, Wind Internethaus GmbH Internet-Service, Am Krebsgraben 15, 78048 Villingen-Schwenningen. Wind Internethaus GmbH records and processes your personal data on our behalf (on the basis of an agreement concerning commissioned data processing) as required for processing the contract.

We will treat all of your data as strictly confidential, in accordance with statutory provisions.

2 Collection and Processing of Data

Continental Automotive GmbH only stores the personal data of users of the WorkshopReport if consent was given for this purpose. Only the following data is saved:

- Data on the vehicle owner (name, address, contact person, telephone numbers, email, country)
- Data on the workshop (name, address, WS card number, technician name, telephone numbers, email, country)
- Time and reason for testing.

Furthermore, Continental Automotive GmbH may evaluate technical data, such as vehicle data (VIN number, vehicle license plate manufacturer, type), the last test (date, reason for the testing, download certificate number, sealing foil number), the tachograph (manufacturer, type, serial number), the sensor (manufacturer, serial number) and workshop data for statistical purposes. Personal user data is solely used to process inquiries within the context of the consent granted or in compliance with applicable data protection regulations. Based on legal requirements, Continental has enforced global, uniform and internal data protection rules (the Binding Corporate Rules), which regulate the protection of personal data.

Continental Automotive GmbH uses the data you enter into the WorkshopReport for reporting, such as name, company, email address, address and telephone number, for the purpose of communicating directly with you.

You undertake to only save your customers' personal data on Continental Automotive GmbH systems if they have consented to have their data collected, processed and saved. Furthermore, you undertake to conform to data privacy law regulations.

3 The Data Subject's Rights

3.1 Please note that, as the party concerned, you have the following rights with regard to the processing of your personal data in accordance with the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (EU GDPR):
